

DRAINAGE PERMIT INFORMATION

- (1) Types: New Drainage Permit-\$100 and Routine Maintenance-No charge (filing required).
- (2) A separate permit is required for each land parcel.
- (3) Fill out permit application completely including landowner and contractor signatures.
- (4) A NRCS map showing area to be drained (no wetlands as defined by NRCS may be drained), and a site map showing layout of proposed tile lines or ditches, sizes of tiles and mark outlets.
- (5) Return to Highway/Drainage Office for research and pay fee (if New Drainage).
- (6) Permit # will be assigned.
- (7) Permit will be returned to applicant for needed acceptance form signatures (if required).
- (8) Review/decision by Drainage Administrator.
- (9) Hearing by Drainage Commission (if required).
- (10) Drainage and routine maintenance permits are valid for 730 days from date of issue.
- (11) **Submit electronic GPS or as built map of completed project within 180 days of installation.**
