The meeting of the McCook County Commission was called to order in their Meeting Room by Chairman Sheldon Butzke. Members present: Ralph Dybdahl and Bill Smith. Members absent: Ron Scharffenberg and Marc Dick.

Chairman Butzke led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Chairman Butzke called for approval of the Agenda adding discussion regarding the Regional Watershed Advisory Task Force. Motion made by Smith to approve the Agenda with addition noted. Second Dybdahl and motion carried.

The minutes from the October 23rd meeting were sent to Board members for review prior to publication. Chairman Butzke called for approval of same. Motion made by Dybdahl to approve the minutes for publication. Second Smith and motion carried.

At 9:10 a.m. the votes from the November 6th General Election were canvassed. The Poll books were reviewed with the number of voters compared to the ballots counted in each precinct and to the Recap Sheet for each precinct; one discrepancy was noted in the Canistota Precinct; possibly due to allowing two Provisional Ballots to be cast. This will be verified by the Auditor's Office.

Auditor Sherman noted a THANK YOU to Brad Wilkins, Advisor, Sarah Schoon, Lauren Miller, Kayty Knudsen, Erin Eickman, Jim Mayrose, Tristen Sullivan, Ben Snyders, and Zane Kirkwood, Junior students from McCook Central School, for their assistance in delivering, set-up/take-down and picking up of the AutoMark voting machines and election supplies to the polling places throughout the county. The help is greatly appreciated.

Mic Kreutzfeldt, Hwy Supt, informed the Commission that the 2002 Tahoe will be used for attending a Safety Conference in Pierre and upon inspection the tires should be changed along with checking right front axle which is leaking. Board approval given to replace tires and have axle checked. Kreutzfeldt presented an update on Bridge #44-006-170 (Emery) Bridge project. Kreutzfeldt reported that he has applied for ER Funds for the Lehrman Lake Channel Restoration; reimbursement of 80% of \$10,000 costs to County. Kreutzfeldt noted a big THANK YOU to the McCook Conservation District for allowing the County to use drill in re-seeding the Lehrman Lake Channel area.

Motion made by Dybdahl to convene as Drainage Commission. Second Smith and motion carried.

At 9:30 a.m. the drainage hearing for Permit D12-066, applicant Dale Seubert, was held. Legal description W2E2SW of 13-101-54 Ex Lot H1 (1.23AC) & W2SW4 Ex Lot H1 (2.11AC) & Ex W12 Rds of S22 Rds (1.65AC) & NSP Tr No 2 (3.67AC).

Drainage Administrator Kreutzfeldt presented permit application information explaining that downstream signatures have been secured except SD Dept of Transportation. D.O.T. is not opposed, but standard practice is to not sign off on the applications. Andy Tieszen was present and questioned the size of downstream culverts. Kreutzfeldt stated that a township can request a larger culvert size in the event that it is needed. With no further discussion, motion was made by Smith to approve Drainage Permit Application D12-066. Second Dybdahl and motion carried.
