The meeting of the McCook County Commission was called to order in their Meeting Room by Chairman Sheldon Butzke. Members present: Ralph Dybdahl, Ron Scharffenberg, Marc Dick, Bill Smith.

Chairman Butzke led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Chairman Butzke called for approval of the Agenda. Motion made by Scharffenberg to approve the Agenda. Second Smith and motion carried.

The minutes from the October 9th meeting were sent to Board members for review prior to publication. Chairman Butzke called for a motion approving same. Motion made by Dybdahl to approve the minutes for publication. Second Smith and motion carried.

Mic Kreutzfeldt, Hwy Supt, presented the following diesel fuel quotes to the Board: Coles Petroleum \$3.4765/gallon; Stern Oil \$3.5072/gallon; Central Farmers Coop, no bid. Motion made by Dick to accept quote from Cole's Petroleum. Second Scharffenberg and motion carried. Kreutzfeldt presented specifications for a hydro statically driven self-propelled chip spreader and the Notice to Bid for same. Motion made by Dybdahl to set 9:30 a.m., Monday, December 3, 2012, as time for bid letting. Second Dick and motion carried. Kreutzfeldt presented pictures of issues with bridge #44-006-170, specifically beams that do not meet specifications and a plan to rectify the issues. Chairman Butzke signed a Maintenance Agreement for Township Border (436th Avenue) between Bridgewater & Union Townships. The original will be retained by the County and copies sent to the respective townships. Auditor Sherman presented a letter

from US Fish & Wildlife Service informing the Commission that the wetland restoration work completed by the Hwy Dept is satisfactory.

Motion made by Dick to convene as Drainage Commission. Second Smith and motion carried.

Drainage Administrator Kreutzfeldt informed the Board that Richland Twp has requested authorization to add a culvert between sections 22 & 23 on south half. Darrell Bies was present. Kreutzfeldt noted that area landowners agree with the Township request. Motion made by Smith to approve placement of an 18" culvert at said location. Second Dick and motion carried.

In other business, Benton Twp has requested authorization to add an 18" culvert across 432nd Ave 2200 feet north of SD38 provided landowner, Michael Gottlob, meets requirements set out by Twp. Motion made by Dick to approve request only when Benton Twp specifications are met by the landowner. Second Scharffenberg and motion carried.

Second Dick and motion carried. Motion made by Dick to approve Plat of Lot 1 in Tract 1 of Schaefer's Addition in the Southeast Quarter of Section 33, Township 101 North, Range 53 West of the 5TH Principal Meridian, McCook County, South Dakota. Second Scharffenberg and motion carried.

Hofer informed the Board that she attended a CAFO Conference held in Brookings; great presentations by Planning District 1 and DENR.

The Board reconvened as Board of County Commissioners.

Carol Lauer, Treasurer, met with Commission to present a request to make payments in the amount of \$720 per month in order to pay up delinquent property taxes; parcel 19.80.05050101 (MH on leased site). This is a 1 year payment plan. Following discussion, the Board agreed to the request. Lauer will notify the property owner.

Auditor Sherman, Mariann Oyen, Benefits Specialist, and the Commission reviewed Care of Poor cases. Three Notices of Hospitalization were received from Avera

McKennan Hospital. One Notice of Hospitalization was received from Avera Queen of Peace Health Services. An Application for County Assistance was approved in part, rent assistance.

The September 17th minutes and the September Financial Statement of the Hanson-McCook Regional Library were noted and filed.

The 3rd quarter Community Health Nurse Report was noted and filed.

On behalf of Alicia Reif, 4-H Youth Advisor, Auditor Sherman informed the Board that speaker, stands, and mic will not be purchased at this time because a laptop computer had to be replaced.

Brad Stiefvater, EDS Director, and the Commission discussed keeping burn ban in place. Stiefvater noted that surrounding counties are keeping the ban in place. Following discussion, it was decided to keep the ban on as are surrounding counties and if circumstances change Stiefvater can have the ban lifted.

The amount of General Fund dollars that counties can retain as surplus is restricted by SDCL 7-21-18.1 which states: "The total unreserved, undesignated fund balance of the general fund may not exceed forty percent of the total amount of all general fund appropriations contained in the budget for the next fiscal year." The total unreserved, undesignated fund balance of the general fund of the county as of September 30, 2012 is \$293,210.34; resulting in a fund balance percentage of 7.14%.
